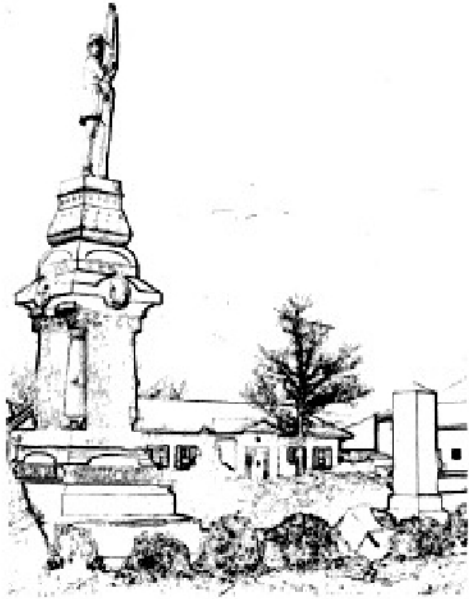
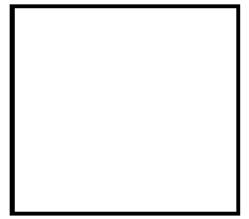

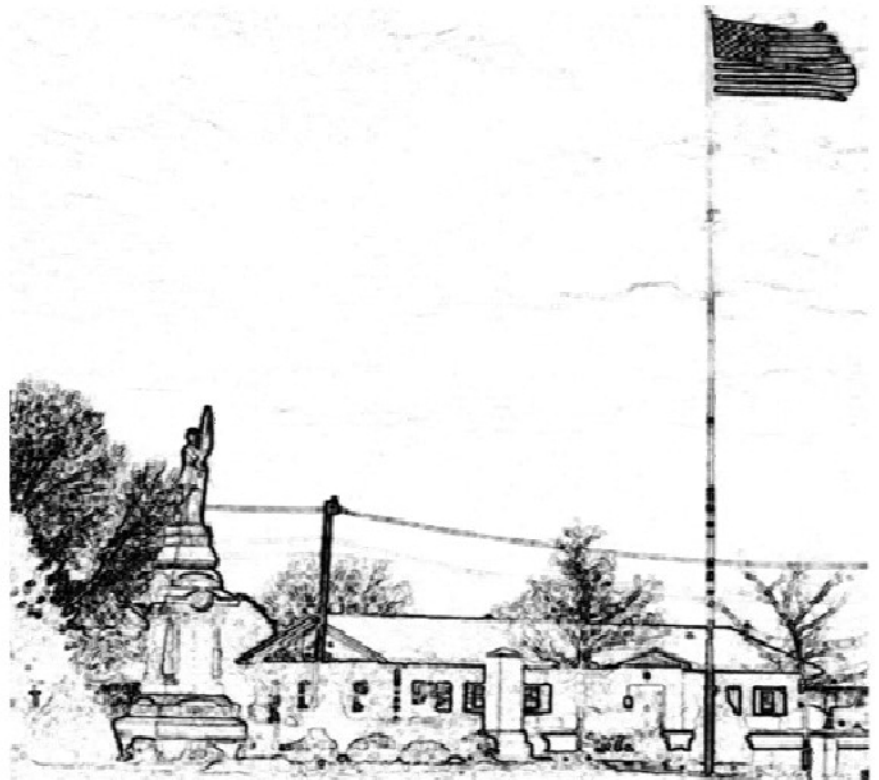

New Pittsfield Maintenance Garage

Last Dumpster Days until Spring!

The trustees have decided to continue with the three-day dumpsters. On Thursday and Friday, September 28 and 29, you can take your items to the garage, and someone will be able to help you from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. On Saturday, September 30, help will be provided from 8 a.m. to Noon. Any other hours, you will be on your own.

Only Pittsfield Township residents may take items to the garage for disposal.

Tires, hazardous liquids, oils, or appliances with freon are NOT accepted.

Oil and Auto Batteries can be recycled at Pier 58 Marine.

If these dates do not work for you, please contact Rumpke at least 48 hours before your regularly scheduled collection to request a large item pick-up or excessive amounts of trash. Please call 800-828-8171 for more details.

REFLECTIVE HOUSE NUMBER SIGNS

The trustees recommend every Pittsfield Township resident have a green reflective house number sign posted at their house.

The signs are free for all Pittsfield Township residents and can be picked up at the Wellington Fire Department.

PITTSFIELD HALL RENTAL

The township hall can be rented for weddings, graduations, showers, funeral lunches etc. The hall comes with an adjoining full-function kitchen. It has a theater-style seating capacity of 100 (chairs only) and a banquet-style seating capacity of 70 (chairs and tables). It features rectangular and round tables, and padded chairs. A security deposit is required and returned if the hall is left in satisfactory condition.

All contracts and deposits must be mailed to Elizabeth Zadorozny at 16645 West Rd, Oberlin, Ohio, 44074. Please call or text Elizabeth before sending contracts or money to confirm dates are open. Dates are held for 5 days for contracts and deposits to be received.

Event person making the payment must be the same person signing the rental agreement.

Pittsfield Residents:

Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Holidays
\$100 Rental + \$100 Security Deposit

Non-Residents:

Friday, Saturday, Sunday & Holidays
\$250 Rental + \$100 Security Deposit

Weekdays (excluding Holidays):

\$75.00 + \$75 Security Deposit

Fund Raising for Non-Profit Organizations

Only: Daily Rate: \$300 + \$300 Security Deposit

Prior Day Set-Up can be scheduled shortly before event if hall is not rented for 4 hours of use for \$50.

Pavilion Use Only Rental: \$25 for all day.

The Neighborhood Alliance Senior Enrichment Center can provide FREE medical equipment for you to rent when the need arises.

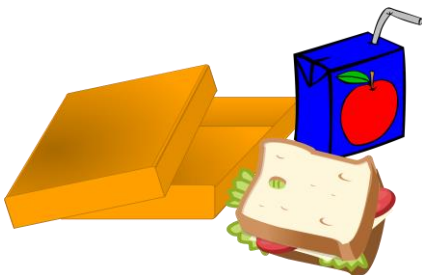
