

## **NEW ZONING FEES AND AMENDMENTS**

At the January 16, 2023, trustee meeting, the following fees and zoning amendments were approved by the trustees after recommended by the Pittsfield Zoning Board.

1. If construction starts without a permit being issued, fees will be doubled.
2. If an agriculture building begins without a permit, a \$50.00 fine will be issued.
3. Pond or Inground swimming pool fee is \$50.00. No permit required for above ground pools.
4. A permit is required for razing or demolishing dwellings or buildings. No fees required.

PITTSFIELD TWP HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

Dear Members & Residents,

Thank you so much for your past support of Pittsfield Twp Historical Society (PTHS). Last year was an exciting year and we accomplished so much.

The 1830's school house now sits on its permanent home next to the township garage. We discovered the schoolhouse's age may be earlier than originally thought. Congressional papers were found stuck to the lath while doing repair work. Those papers dated 1836, 1837, & 1838, indicated the school house was built prior to the 1840's when township buildings were officially documented.

Our open house celebrating its move was held in September and we had great attendance and community support.

Ralph Hayes, our founding president, and Ralph Kies, original owner of property, were able to attend and enjoy the festivities.

Finish the schoolhouse plaster interior & reseal the shingled roof.

The trustees have offered us the old barn behind the school house and we hope to begin the planning process for a possible museum.

Our monthly meetings are held every 2<sup>nd</sup> Thursday of the month at the town hall at 7pm. Please feel free to join us!

We are working to finalize the list of programs and events for this year.
